 Committee and Recruitment Board.

- Riley Plotner (North Union High School) plans to study Nursing at the University of Cincinnati.

- Bryce Piwtorak (Fairbanks High School) will study Nursing at West Virginia University, and plans
 to become a Trauma Nurse. He has participated in Memorial Hospital's Student Volunteer
